- Limit inspections
- Protect yourself by staying hydrated with electrolytes and taking breaks!
- Make sure bees have a large and consistent water source.
- Pests peak in the summer! Be vigilant!

She made a point that winter prep starts June/July with the key to success is good food and good brood.
